Dear Members and Friends,

Dr. R. Gerald McMurtry, authority on Abraham Lincoln and Director of Lincoln National Life Foundation at Fort Wayne, Indiana, will speak to the Society, January 27, 1972, at 7:30 p.m. in the small auditorium at Everett High School, 3900 Stabler, Lansing.

Since 1931, Dr. McMurtry has been actively engaged in historical research dealing with many phases of the life and career of the 16th president. He is the author of 25 books and pamphlets and approximately 250 magazine articles on Lincoln and his comtemporaries. At present, he is editor of Lincoln Lore, a monthly publication dealing exclusively with Lincolniana.

In 1957, President Dwight D. Eisenhower appointed Dr. McMurtry as a member of the National Lincoln Sesquicentennial Commission. This commission commemorated the 150th anniversary of Lincoln's birth.

In September 1959, Dr. McMurtry was sent to Southeastern Asia by the International Education Exchange Service of the State Department as an American specialist to lecture on Lincoln.

He is quite active on the lecture platform, and in his highly specialized field of history, he has made many noteworthy literary contributions to the study of Lincoln.

Dr. McMurtry has been engaged continuously in the study of Lincoln and contemporary history for the past 38 years, and is well qualified to speak with authority on almost any phase of the Lincoln saga.

His talk has been arranged by the local representative, Emil G. Ellis of the Lincoln National Insurance Company.
