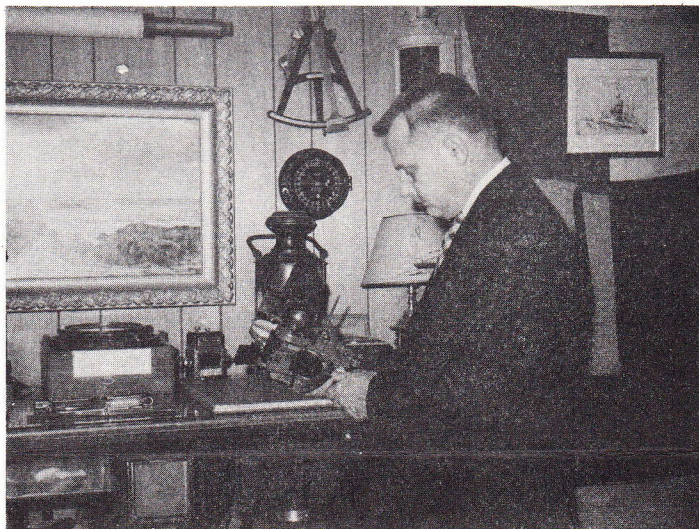


HISTORICAL SOCIETY OF GREATER LANSING
